

Each month we continue to send out hundreds of introductory letters to nursing care facilities. These letters explain who we are and how to view our online services. We are reaching more facilities than we have ever imagined. After we cover all of the facilities in Oklahoma we will expand to adjoining states and beyond.

As you all know we are streaming live services on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 2 pm CT. This is two services per week where before we were providing, at the most, two services per month to each facility. A couple times a month we may do an old time hymn sing. On this occasion we pulled out the old hymn 'Happiness Is The Lord'.

Residents are still struggling with loneliness and depression. The majority of nursing care facilities are still closed. When we can bring the joy of the Lord into people's lives, it is a good thing. The joy of the Lord is our strength - Nehemiah 8:10. Then we always close the service with the opportunity to accept Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior or come back to Him.
