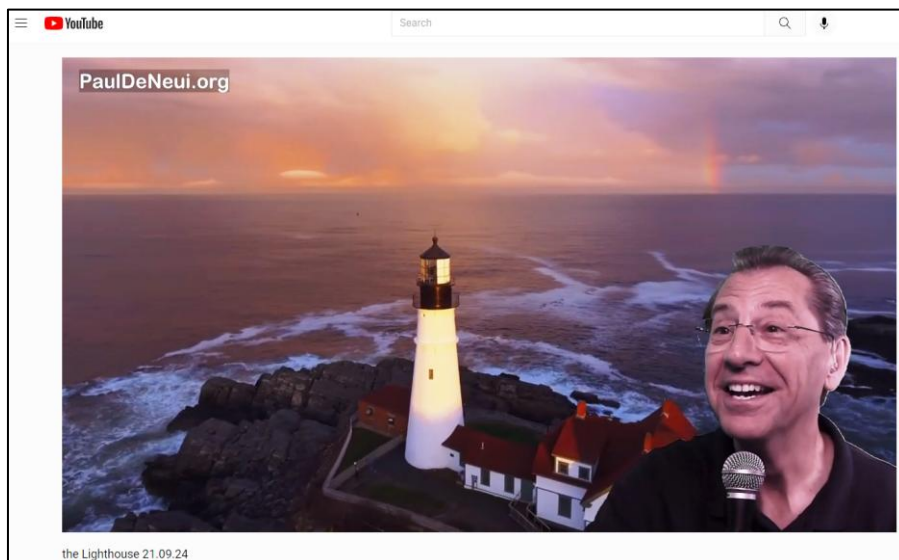
Dear Friends,

way we are going to go. Jesus says, "Choose Life."

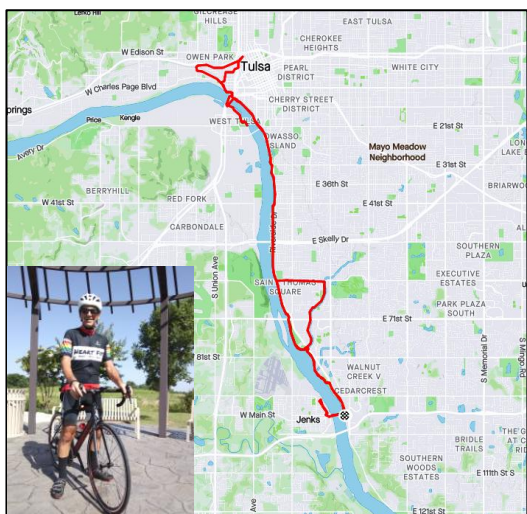
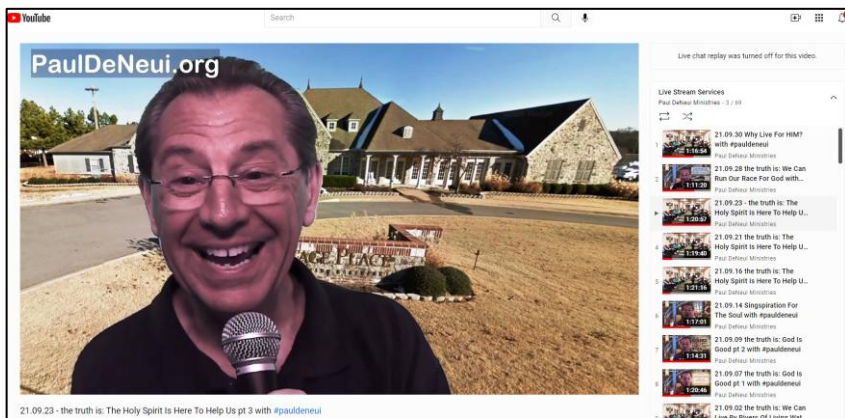
One of the things that the residents really liked during the in-person services was the southern gospel specials. As I had been thinking about and wondering what I could do online, I decided to start producing some southern gospel videos. These will be available on YouTube and will be used in the online services. I have completed one so far and it is "The Lighthouse". My next project is "Beulah Land".





In the last few months, we have sent out 211 introduction letters to nursing care facilities explaining our online services. An approximate number of 100 beds per facility is fairly close. That brings the possibility of 20,000+ residents to a service, not counting the availability of this service to the general public. Even at 50% that is 10,000 people. We have another 69 letters to mail out. That will complete the mailing for Oklahoma. Then we begin mailing to other states.

As we continue to minister online, I have been trying to make the services as personal as possible. At the beginning of each service, we are highlighting one of the nursing care facilities I have ministered in since 2009. I always wave at everyone who may be watching from that facility. Then I always give a wave to everybody who is watching.



Physical exercise means a lot to me. I understand that if you do not have the ability to “GO”, you will be limited in ministry. I understood that even more when in 2016 the Lord wanted me to do something I could not physically do. He wanted me to start ministering to the homeless along the bike trails. So after a couple of years of being on my bike again, I believe I can “GO” where God wants me to go. This last week I was down along the river in Tulsa. Not only is it good ministry, but it’s good exercise. 33 miles and done.

I just want you to know that I think my supporters are the best. You understand the biblical principles of seedtime and harvest. Of sowing and reaping. We continue to pray for each and every one of you. We believe that God will abundantly supply, over and above, all you could imagine or think.
